NOTICE

This is to inform all the dental practitioners that Dental Council of India has issued a Public Notice dated 6/12/22 Vide Notification no. 130 (ARPM-GENERAL)- 2022/97 regarding "Guidelines for the practice of aesthetic & hair transplant procedures for Oral & Maxillofacial surgeons". These procedures can also be undertaken by an Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeon registered with any State Dental Council in India. It is unethical to train an individual to perform /assist surgery who is not an accredited professional licensed to do so.

Haryana State Dental Council has come to know that some dental practitioners are not following the Code of ethics ie. Revised dentist (Code of ethics) Regulation,2014. Not following code of ethics leads to unethical practice such as

- use of abbreviation after Dental Surgeon's name which are not academic qualifications
- Indulging in Surrogate advertisement in the garb of Educating Public through TV program, Magazines or periodicals
- Doing aesthetic & Hair Transplant procedures in contravention to the Guidelines issued by DCI
- Employing any agent or canvasser for the purpose of obtaining patients in a manner that is commercial.
- False Promises regarding treatment and Direct marketing
- Accepting gifts/cash/ travel facilities from pharmaceuticals companies or their sales person.

The undersigned insists all the dental practitioners to go through the Code of ethics ie. Revised dentist (Code of ethics) Regulation,2014 thoroughly & follow them strictly. Dental practitioners not following code of ethics calls for disciplinary action & can lead to removal of name from dental register.

The undersigned also request all the dental professionals to report to the competent authorities instances of quackery & any kind of abuse.
